

EPA Research Prizes 2010

The European Psychiatric Association seeks to award young psychiatrists, working in Europe, who have published the best scientific papers in the year 2009

Research Prizes of € 2,500 will be awarded to the winning authors

Candidates can apply for one or several of the five categories:

- 1. Clinical psychopathology and refinement of psychiatric diagnostic categories
- 2. Biological correlates and treatments of mental disorders
- 3. Psychiatric epidemiology, social psychiatry and psychotherapeutic interventions in mental disorders
- 4. Child & Adolescent Psychiatry
- 5. Improve the Quality of Psychiatric Research & Treatment in Europe

HOW TO APPLY?

The application file should include the following documents (in 4 copies):

- Application form downloadable at EPA website (www.europsy.net)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Documentary evidence for being less than 40 years of age (copy of ID)
- A scientific paper in the field of one of the five prize categories published in the year 2009 in a journal indexed in the Current Contents

Application should be received by 18 November 2009, at:

All documents must be submitted in English.

Electronic submissions will not be considered.

Back-to-back printing recommended.

Do not staple documents.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Working as a psychiatrist, or working in research in psychiatry, or being a resident in psychiatry in a European country.
- 2. Being less than 40 years of age (as of December 31, 2009).
- 3. Being the first author of a scientific paper published in the year 2009 in a journal indexed in the Current Contents, which topic falls within one of the above-mentioned areas.

SELECTION:

The jury will be made up of Hans-Jürgen Möller, EPA President, Cyril Höschl, EPA Past President, and Patrice Boyer, EPA President Elect.

AWARD CEREMONY:

The prizes will be awarded at the opening ceremony of the 18th European Congress of Psychiatry in Munich, Germany, 27 February 2010 at 18:30.
